Foreign Language Requirement

Students seeking an undergraduate degree from Texas A&M International University must demonstrate college-level proficiency in a foreign language. The College of Arts and Sciences has additional language requirements for the BA degree. Proficiency is defined as the equivalent of 6 college level semester credit hours (SCH) of a foreign language. College-level proficiency may be demonstrated by:

1. completion of three years of high school study of a single foreign language with a minimum grade of 80 (3.0) at the end of the third year, **or**
2. completion of two years of high school study of a single foreign language and completion of a 2000 level university course in the same language with a “C” or better, **or**
3. earning a minimum grade of “C” in 6 SCH in a foreign language, **or**
4. completion of an approved international experience (study abroad) of at least one semester/summer session in length in a country where English is not the primary language, **or**
5. CLEP or AP exam scores that award 6 SCH in a foreign language, **or**
6. completion of two courses in a language with a “C” or better from the University’s International Language Institute, **or**
7. completion of two American Sign Language courses with a “C” or better.
